RE: Discounted NMVTIS Reporting through Auto Data Direct for Checkmate and Fast Parts Customers

Dear Checkmate or Fast Parts customer:

As you may know, regulations setting forth the Requirements and Procedures for Consumer Assistance to Recycle and Save Program were released by the National Highway Traffic Safety Administration ("NHTSA") today. These regulations contain the requirements and procedures for participation in the Car Allowance Rebate System ("CARS"). The CARS regulations require a disposal facility that acquires a vehicle traded in under the CARS program to report the vehicle into the National Motor Vehicle Title Information System ("NMVTIS") within 7 days after receiving the vehicle and to make subsequent NMVTIS reporting once the vehicle is crushed or shredded.

Car-Part.com has arranged for discounted NMVTIS reporting for Checkmate and Fast Parts users through Auto Data Direct, an authorized NMVTIS data consolidator. Checkmate and Fast Parts users will be able to register with Auto Data Direct for a discounted registration fee of \$50 – a savings of \$50 from Auto Data Direct's standard registration fee. Checkmate and Fast Parts users will also receive a substantial discount on Auto Data Direct's per VIN reporting fees. Auto Data Direct has also informed us that it will be providing NMVTIS reporting free of charge for vehicles acquired under the CARS program.
